Update on SB 819

The Governor signed SB 819 into law last Fall thereby authorizing NPs to certify state disability, order DME and home health services for their patients in California. NPs will need to integrate these provisions into existing SPs/Process Protocol documents and obtain the necessary collaborative approvals per your work environment in order to begin to incorporate them into the role. CANP has an area on the web site to access BRN information or you can go directly to the BRN site.

Members of the Health Policy and Practice Committee will be presenting at the March CANP Conference to provide the background information needed for authorization of home health and DME services and state certification of disability. There has been some discussion regarding the idea of creating a template for NPs to help facilitate these changes.
